Regulatory obligations and adherence to conduct principles

- Global regulatory agenda: Basel III, CRD IV, MiFID II, MAR, SM&CR, FRTB, GDPR.....
- New principles and best practice guidelines on conduct and behaviour: FX Global Code, UK MM Code, UK PM Code....

Global Code Certificate:

- Excellent first step to demonstrating (attesting to) clear understanding of themes and principles of new Global Code

Dealing Certificate:

- For new entrants to financial markets and junior dealers in the dealing room; middle office and operations personnel; auditors and compliance officers.


Dealing Simulation Course
